Readmission Criteria and Procedures for Current Residents – New College 2021 - 2022

Criteria (in alphabetic order, with equal weighting):

- Academic performance
- Attendance in Orientation and High Table Dinners, if applicable (These activities are compulsory unless with valid and in-time leave application)
- Evaluation by the tutor on the collegial relationship, learning attitude, initiative and sense of responsibilities
- Performance in experiential and service learning as attendees and helpers (or organizers and leaders for residents applying for the third year of stay) in the College and the Community.
- Peer Review by the residents on the same floor on collegial relationship
- Records of violation of college rule and misbehaviour

Procedures:

The Admission Panel will review the information submitted by the applicants in the internal application, the peer review, evaluation from tutorial staff as well as the record of violation. An Interview will be offered to each applicant. Integrating the information collected from different sources based on the criteria described above, as well as the available vacancies for different groups of students, the applicants will be grouped into “re-admit”; “reject” or “pending”.

Those who are not identified as “re-admit” in the internal application can lodge an appeal. All appeals must be based on new information related to the application of readmission. Appeal interviews will be offered for appellants whose categories with available vacancies.
